Many thanks to the **Academy of Dentistry International (ADI)** for contributing \$1,000 to the Christian Dental Society, which will be used to help purchase an Aseptico, Task Force Deluxe, self-contained, portable, dental operating unit to be used around the world to help the underserved dentally.

The CDS also thanks Aseptico, for their 20% missionary discount, which makes the unit very affordable at about \$2500.

The ADI, which has members in over 80 countries, is devoted to the advancement of dentistry though out the world, and the improvement of the oral health of citizens of every nation ([www.adint.org](http://www.adint.org)). The number of short-term dental missions the CDS is helping equip around the world continues to increase, and we have not been able to keep up with the demand for Dental Operating Units. The CDS so appreciates the ADI for their valuable contribution to our mission of encouraging, assisting, teaching and equipping dental missions to the glory of God's kingdom.

Dr. Andrew Walls, a CDS Advisory Council member, recently traveled to Thailand on a dental mission trip with his family and found that Thailand's new equipment and drug rules severely restrict short-term missions. Foreigners are no longer allowed to bring anesthetic, needles, amalgam, composite, or medications into the country, but must purchase them in Thailand. Any equipment brought must have import paperwork done ahead of time through the Thai FDA and then donated to the organization to remain in country. Dr. Walls left his portable dental set-up in Thailand and has offered to let other missionary dentists use it. He has information on how to obtain supplies.
