Governmental red tape, in-country confusion, and customs forced the cancelation of two student trips and a coordination trip recently. Dr. Carney is hoping to start student trips again in the Fall. We will keep you posted.

Most of our membership is using the “Pressure Pot” sterilization method which rapidly and easily sterilizes instruments in 10-minutes with the additional weight (which can be purchased from the CDS) on the regulator. Recently, Dr. Eli Davidyan from Beverly, Massachusetts, whom the CDS met at a Yankee dental convention exhibit booth, had a helpful recommendation for a pressure pot basket that can be used to lift the hot sterilized instruments out of the pot. It can be purchased from Amazon for about \$12 by looking up HapWay Stainless Steel Steamer Basket shown below.

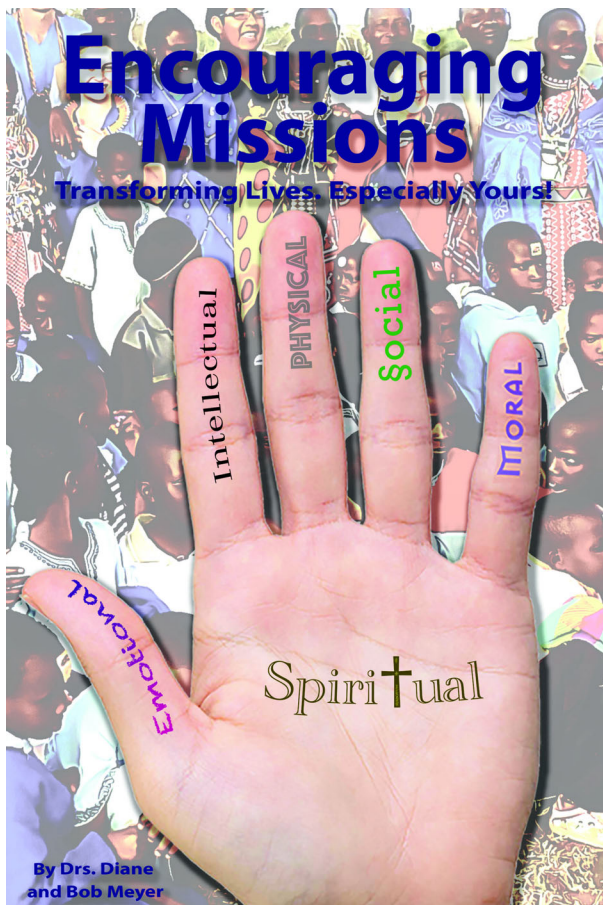

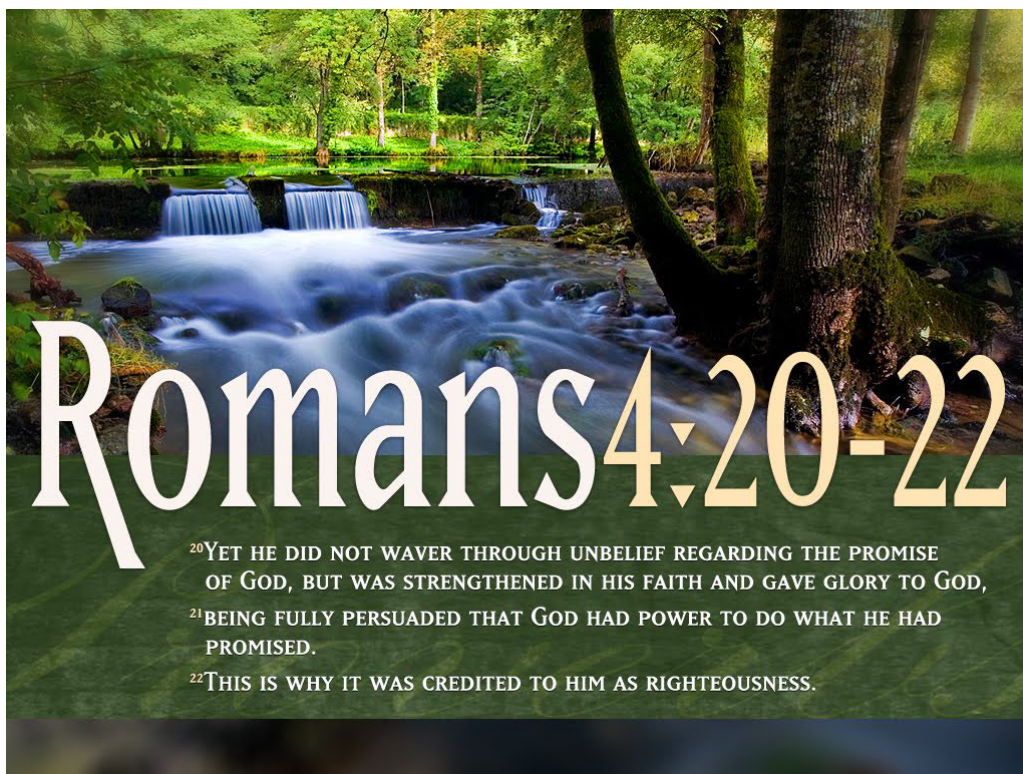
