Highlights of the major items of discussion and decisions made at the 2016 CDS Board Meeting:

1. The CDS Board elected a new President, **Dr. Denny Scharine**, who has served the CDS Board and who has been a previous President of the CDS. Dr. Denny has a comprehensive dental practice in Fremont, Wisconsin, was inspired to dental missions by the CDS, and has traveled to Belize, Guatemala, Ecuador, Mexico, Kenya, Liberia, Thailand, Ghana, Nigeria, India, Indonesia, and Uganda. **Dr. Denny and his wife, Bonny** recently celebrated their 39th anniversary on their way to a dental mission to Myanmar. The CDS is blessed to have such a capable Christian leader and a totally mission-minded servant as our new President.

2. CDS elected a new President-Elect, **Dr. Dave Moretz**, who will take over as President in two years. Dr. Dave has been our large equipment manager since 2011 and is an invaluable asset to our dental equipment rental program. Dr. Dave practices dentistry part-time in North Carolina and served in the Peace Corps in Nepal early in his career. He has been active in dental missions since 1990, concentrating in Mexico and Honduras. We are thankful for **Dr. Dave and his wife Gail**, who are willing and capable of leading our great organization.

3. **Dr. Randy Sanders**, our small equipment manager, reported on our surgical and restorative kits and showed the Board our three new hygiene kits, which include a stand-alone ultrasonic, added this year to our inventory of kits CDS can rent out to assist our members. **Dr. Dave Moretz** reported on our portable dental chairs and dental operating units. Both stated that CDS is sending out more kits and equipment to a larger number of countries and to more new members than ever before. Our sincere appreciation to **Dr. Randy and Dr. Dave** for all they do to facilitate missions around the world.

4. **Dr. Bob Meyer and CDS Treasurer, Dr. Jody Yarbrow** gave the yearly financial report showing that CDS is doing well with the budget. Thank you to **Dr. Jody** for all of his work as CDS Treasurer. Our membership has grown to 464 members and the Board did not feel a need to raise dues. We would rather encourage others to join the CDS.

5. The CDS Board solidified a number of concerns concerning membership:

a. A retired dentist or a non-working dentist will pay a yearly due of \$75 and be granted full Active Membership to enable him/her to vote and to rent equipment.

b. A retired hygienist or a non-working hygienist will pay a yearly due of \$40 and be granted Active Membership to enable him/her to vote and to rent equipment. A hygienist can now become a Life Member for \$800.

c. Dental students who have gone on a CDS mission are granted free membership until December of their graduation year. If they want to rent equipment, after they graduate, they can become an Active Member by paying dues which will be good through December of the following year.

d. If a prospective member applies for a CDS membership after August, he/she may pay half dues, since CDS runs on a January to December billing cycle. If membership is applied for after October, the dues will cover until December of the following year.

e. The CDS will offer, for the first time, an opportunity for CDS members to automatically renew their memberships. Information will be sent out in the upcoming dues notice.

6. The CDS, with **Paul Shada and Bell Dental**, has modified our five Aseptico Task Force units. The cases were not durable enough to withstand the rigors of shipping and the use on the mission field. Paul reconfigured the components of the Aseptico unit and secured them in a hardened Pelican case with handle and wheels, which has proven durable enough to be shipped and used on the mission field. A big thanks to **Paul Shada**.

7. **Paul Shada** and Bell Dental has also developed a new Portable Dental Operating Unit which was demonstrated at the Board Meeting. CDS decided to buy two of these units to add to our rental inventory.

8. **Dr. Gayle Cheatwood** has developed a Battery-operated Dental Operating Unit which was demonstrated at the Board Meeting. CDS decided to buy two of these units to add to our rental inventory. We now have a unit which will work off a car battery and can be charged with a solar cell. With a converter, the unit can also be used with 110V or 220V. Thank you **Dr. Gayle (and Mike York)**, who have helped in this unit development.

9. CDS members exhibited at ten major dental conventions last year, only costing our organization a total of \$1700. This has been an extremely valuable opportunity to encourage, assist, and connect.
