Christian Dental Society News-Brief July, 2016

Our CDS Website has a new look! It should be completed this week and we encourage you to check it out on www.christiandental.org. Please verify that all contact information is correct. There is a public member list where office data is listed, so patients and prospective patients can locate and contact our members. There is also a private member list (which is password protected) where home address, e-mail and phone number are entered. If you do not have the CDS password, contact the home office. Many thanks to the Curtis Group for designing the website and working with the CDS on this.

We have been reviewing and updating our **CDS** insurance coverage. The CDS has liability protection for our officers and board, we have a security bond against monetary theft, and we carried limited coverage on our property. We have not had general liability insurance to cover us for meetings and gatherings (this year we will exhibit at ten different dental conventions and have several meetings). General liability coverage has become a requirement for organizations to exhibit at conventions and to hold meetings. In searching five different insurance agencies during the last six months to come up with a reasonable plan to insure the CDS, we have finally found one to meet our needs at a very reasonable price. We have combined a general liability policy to cover us for all our gatherings with a new increased property coverage to insure our assets (equipment, kits, and administrative office). In this litigious society, we have to protect ourselves and cannot conduct business without proper insurance coverage. We want to assure you that we have addressed the issues.

The CDS has just rented our first **Dental Hygiene Kit** which includes an ultrasonic scaler. Thanks to **Dr. Randy Sanders** for putting the kits together, as CDS now has three hygiene kits available for rent for \$75 each.

We have converted our five Aseptico Deluxe portable dental operating units into a hard Pelican case, as we previously had difficulties with the cases not holding up to the rental market. **Thank you, Paul Shada from Bell Dental** for engineering this for our dental operating units.

We are renting out more equipment and kits than ever before to new members. The word is getting out about how we can help dental missions. We thank Dr. Randy Sanders, Dr. Dave Moretz, and Tina for their many hours of work assisting others with dental missions by renting out equipment and kits.

All Board members and Advisory Council members are strongly encouraged to attend.
